Became interested in wireless in Boston 1909 while Western Union operator. Used Ford & Rhumkorf spark coils, and minerals for detector. Worked W1SS, Art, many times. Left Boston 1912 to work for W.U. Tel., in Cincinnati, then to Dallas. Installed first teletype machines for A.P. in N.Y. 1914, for N.Y.C. RR, for Rock Island RR, for Canadian Pacific RR, and many others. Began experimenting with Wireless Teletype 1920. First Class Comm'l. License. Installed first wireless teletype between Chicago and Lake Geneva. Back on air 1938 with Viking 11 to present.

First License 1914, 2AAO. On air with 330 watt spark rig. U.S. Navy WW1. Owned and operated broadcast station in Albany 1922. Licensed Civil Engr. and First Class Comm. Radio Operator. Holds Extra Class Amateur License. Past Pres. Albany Amateur Radio Assn., Asst. Director of ARRL.

#107 LAMSON, Myles L., W1GU, Ex-1SE, 1GR, W1GHE, W51JB, W2GD. Handle "Mike". Born October 10, 1901. First 2-way wireless contact 1911-1912. Present occup: Broadcast Engineer. Early years-wireless operator, merchandise service, also CRM U.S. Coast Guard. Pan American Airways-Communications and presently Chief Engineer at WRKD Rockland, Me., with a sideline of poultry farming.
