Began learning Morse telegraphy in freight depot of Ann Arbor, RR., Aug. 1898 at Alma, Michigan. Jan. 1900 quit A.A. RR. went to work for Pere Marquette RR. at Ludington, Mich. Resigned 1902 to work for Great Northern R.R. at Rugby Junction, N.D. Went with Western Union short time later and was with them 48 years. Was Secretary Saginaw Rotary Club 1938-1960. Pres. of Radio Research Club and Motor City Radio Club, Detroit. Member ARRL since WW1. Trustee Saginaw Valley Radio Association.
