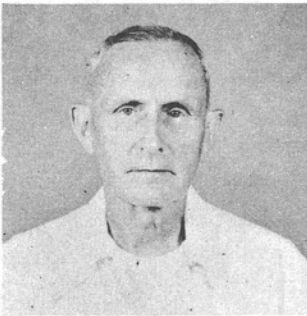


#113 FLANNER, Norris E., Ex-W2ZSP. Handle "Norris".

2-way wireless contact 1912.



#115 DOTEN, Harold B., Ex-W4KJ. Handle "Harold". Born
October 29, 1892. First 2-way wireless contact 1907. Lieut.
Cmdr. U.S.C.G. (Ret.). Started with electrolytic and spark
coil. First Class Comm. License November 27, 1911. Deep
sea comm. opr. and U.S. Navy CRM on N.Dakota, where wireless
crew hospitalized by coal fumes-medical discharged from USN
joined U.S. C.G. was sub. Cable Supervisor Phila.Navy Yard
with Capt. Brown on Pequot-CWO-E (Tel.Lines) repairing cables
to the lighthouses way out to sea. Harold is 70 years old
and was in C.G. 26 years and has many tales for "Spark Gap
Times."



#116 STEVENS, Thomas M., Ex-W6KAA. Handle "Tom". Born
October 13, 1885. First 2-way wireless contact Mar. 17,
1904. Occup: Lt. Cmdr. USN (Ret.) & Comm. Consultant U.S.N.
and FCC. Joined Navy in Texas 1902. Assigned to Dynamo Room
on U.S.S. Iowa and transferred to wireless when 1st inst. was
made. Discharged EML/c Oct. 1906. Worked for De Forest
Wireless Tel. Co. later with United Wireless at San Antonio,
Houston, and Beaumont, Texas. On N.Y. to Havana run as Rdo.
Opr. Later appointed Mgr. United Wireless, Boston Office
1909. With Marconi Co. 1912. Supt. Southern Div. Baltimore
Md. 1913-1915. (Supt. Pacific Div. 1916). (U.S.N. WW1
1916-19), (Joined RCA 1920-Gen'l. Supt.) (FCC until 1950.)
