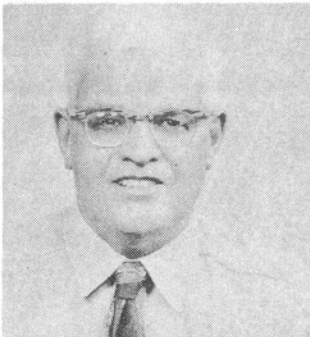


#125 MCLEAN, Archibald S., W1JQ. Handle "Mac". First 2-way wireless contact 1912.
