#138 EMIGH, Charles M., W7ER. Handle "Chuck". Born December 29, 1894. First 2-way wireless contact 1908. Occup: Electronic Salesman. Started in 1908 with Ford spark coil and a silicon detector. Soon stepped up to a 1 kw transformer with a rotary spark gap. Went through the usual stages of gear. Was Chief Radioman in the Naval Reserve for 12 years. In 1910 a publication called Modern Electronics carried a story written by "Chuck" about his wireless. "Chuck" received \$3.00 for the story. The article in part reads: "I have received as far down as So. California, up as far as Sitka, and 2000 miles out to sea."
