#143 HAZLETON, Ralph L., KL7AG, Ex-6IH. Handle "Ralph".
Born April 19, 1898. First 2-way wireless contact 1912.
Occup: Station Manager, Federal Aviation Agency. Started
in Santa Cruz, Cal. 1910 with Ford spark coil, straight
gap, Helix, etc. Receiver single slide tuner, Galena de-
tector, 75 OHM phone. Licensed 6IH 1913. Advanced to
larger rig and was good customer Wm. B. Duck Co., E.I. Co.,
Murdock, etc. Joined Navy 1917. Served as RM on U.S.S.
Oregon and U.S.S. Marblehead. Discharged August 1919, ob-
tained First Class Comm. license and went to sea for SOR,
IWT, and Statesline of Portland. In 1930 quit the sea for
ground work as airways keeper.



#144 MOWRY, C. Edward Sr., K8AEB. Handle "Ed". Born
December 24, 1900. First 2-way wireless contact September
1914. Occup: Radio Operator-Boat Dispatcher C. & O. Rail-
way. Started in 1914 using Ford spark coil and a Wm. B.
Duck Co. NAA loose coupler receiver at Monroeville, O.
This station was dismantled at the start WW1. Secured First
Class Commercial License March 7, 1918 at Detroit, S.W.
Edwards, R.I., in charge. Still holds Comm. license and
have been employed in Radio Communications since that time.
Forty years later he returned to the bands as K8AEB. Holds
DXCC-WAS-WAC-OTC-OOTC-RCC.
