



#213 RINGLER, Addison N., W2SAW, handle "Sax". First 2-way wireless contact 1919. Born January 4, 1905.



#214 MARTIN, George H., Ex-W6EWI. Handle "George". Born December 31, 1891. First 2-way wireless contact 1909. Occup: Pacific Telephone Co. Traffic Engineering-retired after 32 years service. Had spark transmitter operating in pre-license days, about 1909-1910. Obtained Commercial First Class License August 11, 1914. Joined U.S. Marines 1917 and was Signal Officer of the 11th Regiment A.E.F. in France 1918-1919.



#215 FRENCH, Hollis M., Ex-W1JLK. Handle on CW "Deke". Born May 14, 1898. First 2-way wireless contact fall of 1912. Present occup: Retired Clergyman. Served as Assistant Technical Editor of QST magazine and Assistant Secretary of ARRL 1943-1945. Two sons served in Air Force 1943-1945 (William), and 1952-1956 (John). "Both now married and I have two grandsons and a granddaughter. Son John in radio in Air Force but neither is a ham. The old man obviously served as a horrible example for them."



#216 TURNER, Van, Ex-W2KE, Ex-3JM, Handle "Van". Born Jan. 18, 1902. First 2-way wireless contact 1920. Present occup: Sgt. at Arms-Gloucester County Dist. Court. Bitten by wireless bug 1919-licensed 3JM. Moved to Chicago-W9EBG. Active duty WW2 Lst. Lieut. Air Corps. Served entire time as Commun. Officer at Santa Ana Air Base, Calif. Separated as Major. Tech. Writer and Sales Prom. Mgr., Sun Oil Co., Phila. Poor health forced retirement from pressur jobs. Married, 20 year old daughter at Glassboro State College. Founder and first Pres. Gloucester Co. Radio Club. Worked W1ZE (KHHA) on spark also 5ZA, 3CC, etc.
