Attended Univ. of Kansas worked 9XP. 1917-18 Liason Officer U.S. Army. 1918 returned to school, graduated 1920. 1920-26 with U.S. Bureau of MInes experimenting with "wired wireless" for rescue. 1926-1930 Research Engr. with Western Precipitation Co., 1930-1950 Pres. and Director Research International Geophysics. 1959 to date Pres. & Director of Research for Electrophysics Corp. Mfgr. Electronic devices.



#290 HOLMES, J.J. Sk, Ex-VEIAJ, Ex-VEIBT. Handle "Jimmy".
Born Jan. 25, 1894. In Yorkshire, G.B. first 2-way contact 1912.
Occup: Retired Supt. Safety Dept. Dominion Iron and Steel Co.
Became interested in wireless 1911. Built entire rig except head set. Attended wireless school Vancouver B.C. 1915 and obtained First Class Commercial License. Deep sea wireless operator for Canadain Marconi 1915-1922. On ships running overseas during WW1 was torpedoed and shelled by U-boat. Left sea 1922 and was with Dom. Steel 38 years. Full member Sydney Amateur Radio Club. ARRL and Nova Scotia Amateur Radio Assoc.

Did no more hamming until 1960 when K4DK was issued on July 7, 1960. Has 40 and 80 meter dipoles and a hornet TB-1000-4 up about 40 feet, Viking Valiant XMTR and Mohawk receiver.
