Spent 3 years as Radio Operator U.S. Coast Guard, 5 years in Merchant Marine 2 of which were with Tropical Radio. Spent 15 years in various capacities with Press Wireless, N.Y. Was among early sidebanders in 1949. Hold certificate #4 for 100 countries 2X SSB, DXCC and WAZ. Likes DX and ragchewing, married with 3 children, 2 boys and a girl.



#330 WILDER, Hartland Bates SK, VE2SF, Ex-2AK. Handle "Hartland". Born April 29, 1898. First 2-way wireless contact, 1912. Occup: Chief Mech. Engr. for Can. Aviation Electronics (Retired). Marconi Operator 1916. Can. Navy 1917 to the end of war, transport service. B. Sc. McGill University 1922. Divil Engr. installed radio on trains 1922 for Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul R.R. was in retail radio business 1924-1935. Mostly engaged in Mechanical Engineering 1935-1958, for Marconi Co., Atomic Energy Commission, and C.D. Howe.



#331 AREVALO, Nicanor Joaquin, LU9AN, Ex-LU3EP. Handle "Nica". Born Nov. 27, 1899. First 2-way contact, Feb. 22, 1922. Occup: T.V. Construction and Service. Was first in the First contest of radio compasses in 1928 with LU2BA.
