



#340 WHITE, Clarence J. Jr., Sk, Ex-W4KR, 4DT, W2NJY, W8KU. Handle "Clarence". Born Dec. 1, 1903. First 2-way wireless contact 1915. Occup: Prof. Engr. White and Camp. Graduate Georgia Tech. EE. First licensed after WW1 1919 4DT and a Commercial Second Class license. Now hold an Amateur Extra Class and a Radiotelephone First Class License. Hold several Armed Force Day awards, Conn. Wireless Assoc. Code Certif. 40-WPM, ARRL CP-35 WPM, Third Army Mars Certif. 40 WPM, PAM for Georgia, Pres. of Cracker Radio Club and Mgr. of Georgia Cracker Emergency Net.

#341 SWENSON, Walter J. W1CA, Ex-2BTQ, 2ADT, W3PN, K2CP. Handle "Walt". Born May 27, 1907. First 2-way wireless contact 1919. Occup: Transmitter Supervisor WENH-TV. Started in radio broadcasting 1926, went with Paramount Pictures sound newsreel when (talking pictures were new) about 1928. Have been working with television since about 1938. Had one of the first TV receivers in N.Y.C. SK



#342 PHIPPENY, Forrest I., Ex-W6CK, 8CX, W3CG. Handle "Pappy". Born Dec. 13, 1895. First 2-way wireless contact 1907. Occup: Retired Coast Guard Officer. Local boys west of Battle Creek using coherers, decoherers and spark coils began contacting each other in 1907. Radio Inspector Dillon gave exam 1912--first call 8CX. Enlisted U.S. Navy 1916. Left Navy 1922 entered Michigan State University BSEE 1926. Put WKAR on air in 1922. Reenlisted USCG 1929 and retired 1953. Is a charter member ARRL--see 40th anniversary number QST. Was active in radio clubs at E. Lansing, Battle Creek, Wash., and Long Beach.



#343 KEIM, John D., Ex-3AIE. Handle "John". Born December 27, 1897. First 2-way wireless contact 1915. Occup: Electrician. Photo shows equipment on the right (very small portion showing) 2 meter gear with T.U. for FSK and AFSK for mod. 26 RTTY. Old mod. 500 globe king on top globe VFO and BC 221. Next in line HT-33A and HT-32A with phone patch between them. GMT clock on the wall and Johnson Directional Coupler for SWR Indicator above his head. AC Voltmeter and AM-meter on wall with mod. 381 B & W TR SW eliminates last COAX relay to antenna. You can just see the corner of the SX-101A receiver.
