

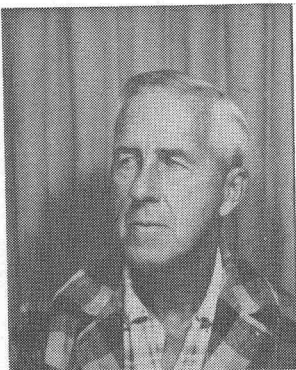

Got first amateur license in December, 1912, No. 1587, issued by Department of Commerce and Labor, Charles Nage, Sec'Y. (See 1913 Call Book.) Exam was taken at the Navy Electrical School in the Brooklyn Navy Yard. Present equipment XMTR B&W 5100, all bands except 160 Gonset Communicator IV with twin 5 beam receivers. 75A4, and SX-42. Ant. 75 & 40 M. dipole. Cubical quad on 10 & 15.
