From Ada went into Signal Corps WW1. After war went to a Radio school in Los Angeles. Licensed 1920 and immediately went to sea for Old Marconi Co. out of San Francisco. His XYL is a ham, WØMFW. Shipowners against MM so no schedules. Hears K6EA while far at sea. Will soon QRT commercial, and ham.

Commercial 2nd Class License (1928-1930). Radioman 1C USNR 1927-1931. Member ARRL-Tops 1068-OTC-RCC. Hold DXCC with 190 countries confirmed, was #1057, WAC/A-1, WAC/A-3, WBE, BERTA, EDXC, CP30, WAE-1, WACAN, OHA, DUF3, WASM2, etc., mostly C.W.
