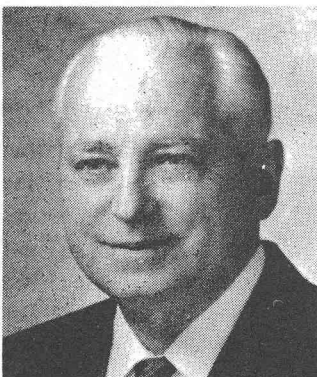


#380 HOSKINSON, J.D., KØBCZ. Handle "J.D. or Joe".

Fire Chief. Started with spark rig with both rotary and Benwood
quenched gap then a C.W. rig with a UV-202 tube in a Hartley
circuit. Member the Cleveland Wireless Association since about
1924. Is a member of the DXCC Honor Roll (combine C.W. and
Phone and Phone alone.)
