

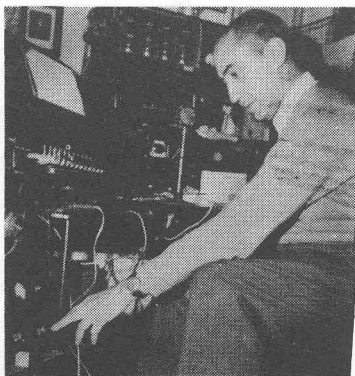

Also Merchants and Miners S.S. Co. S.S. Essex 1919. Early rig Ford spark coil and double slide tuner, $\frac{1}{4}$ kw rotary gap and loose coupler.



#437 HALL, Harlan R., W9CF, Ex-BH, 9CF, 9FC. Handle "Bert". Born July 11, 1897. First two way contact December 1912. Occup: Electronic Engineer. Served WW1 as Chief Electrician (Radio) was Mgr. Radio Dept. of the Commonwealth Edison Co., Chicago Mgr. Radio Dept. Sears Retail Stores 1932. Joined Coleman Inst. Co., Maywood, Illinois as Electronic Engr. 1936. Defense Work in WW2. Then started business as Ultra-sonic Engineering Co. in 1945. Early rig spark coils with two slide tuner, then changed to rotary gap, then obtained an old DeForest audion, wound coupler on linoleum tubing. Member ARRL and Associate of IIIE.
