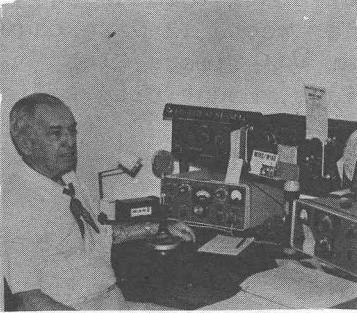

Operator, Engineer Dry Batts. Early rig spark coil, silicon Galena Darning needle rolling pin coil and telephone receiver. Member ARRL, QCWA, Westlake Amateur Radio Assn., ARRL Certificate Emergency (Blizzard) Traffic, A-1 Operator 35 WPM Certificate.



#486 GAMBLE, Frederick, D., W8PL, Ex-8PK, 8EDP, W9EKA. Handle "Fred". Occup: Radio Engineer for Department of Highways, Division of Highway Maintenance. Born March 22, 1900. First two way contact 1914. Had Comm. Telegraph 1916. Radio Operator on Great Lakes, U.S. Navy during WW1 as Radio Operator. Armed Guard, Radio Training in the Brooklyn Navy yard and Pratt Institute. First job was with William B. Duck, Toledo Mail Order and Manufacturing. Always worked in some capacity in Radio field. Early rig 1/4 in. spark coil, Helix Western key with two slide tuning coil Murdock tuning condenser, Galena and silicon detector. Member of Toledo Radio Club 1921, Pres. Greater Cincinnati Radio Club 1950, QCWA and Institute of Radio Engineers now IEEE. Actively engaged on all bands CW and SSB.
