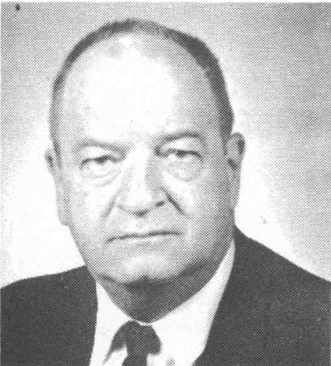

#511 HEINTZ, Ralph M., W6RH, Ex-6XB, 6GK. Handle "Ralph". Born April 20, 1892. First 2-way contact 1907. Occup: Retired 1922-37, Pres. General Mgr. Heintz and Kaufman, Ltd. So. S.F. Radio Equipment and Radio Tubes, 1937-39 Bendix Aviation Corp., Proj. Engineer 1939-48 V.P. and Co-founder Jack and Heintz, Inc. Cleveland Ohio. Early rig, spark coil, electrolytic interrupter, fixed gap, glass jar con, osc, trans, coherer & decoherer, 3 slide tuner. Member IRE, AIEE and now Fellow IEEE, ARRL, QCWA and SSB Assn.

#513 DIEVENDORF, Hugh E., Ex-W3LVP, Ex-8APU, W8NFT. Handle "Hugh". Born Feb. 7, 1908. First 2-way contact February 1921. Occup: Electrical Engineer, was sales agent with IBM, 5 years in Navy as Radioman and Chief Specialist. Early rig, Ford spark coil, and OT, Galena detector next UV-202 COTO coil regn. Member ARRL and Masonic Fraternity.

#514 WADE, John M., Sr. Ex-W1QT., Ex-2OQ, 2AYN. Handle "John". Born Jan. 3, 1897. First two way contact 1912.
