Early rig, Hartley Oscillator, 852 tube and a 210 rig,. Member - Belong to over 30 clubs around the world, Albany Amateur Radio Assn., Schenectady Amateur Radio Assn.



#518 KALE, Samuel, S., Lt.Col., (Ret), W2VU, Ex=3VE, 3AQU, W4HOE, D4ABB, DL4BB. Handle "Sam". Born Oct. 9, 1904. First 2 way contact Feb. 1921. Occup: U.S. Army Retired, now with Army as Pictorial Officer, Fort Dix, N.J. in civilian status, Armored Artillery WW2, Transferred to Sig. Corps. 1949, Chief of Radio TV Branch and Chief American Forces Network in Europe. Early rig 3/4 in. coil later spark coil for CW. Member of South Jersey Radio Assoc.
