

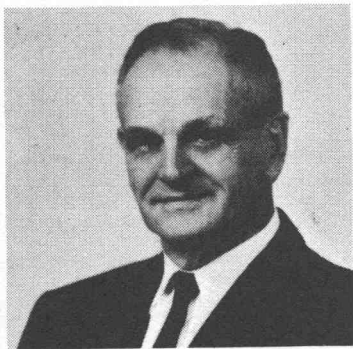
#645 CRONEY, Joseph E., Ex-W5IPP, MZL. Handle "Jim". Born November 30, 1895. First 2-way contact December 1915. Occup: Retired secretary, American Radio Association, served as Radio Operator from 1915 to June 1934. Then became active in Labor movement. Early rig, British Marconi with straight gap spark and magnetic detector. Member Veteran Wireless Operators Assoc., Gold Medal Award and Radio Corp. of America Bronze Medal. S.K. 1970.



#646 DEBEN, John Milton, W5CJO. Handle "Mick". January 13, 1903. First 2-way contact 1913. Occup: Executive Crescent Co. in present position all life. Early rig, Galena detector, high frequency buzzer.



#647 HANSEN, Theodore A., W9IX, Ex-9DXW, 9BHN. Handle "Ted". Born October 25, 1903. First two way contact 1919. Occup: Project Supervisor, Teletype Corp. Have been Radio Inspector, Chicago Office, 1930-1932, Transmitter Engineer WBBM, Chicago 9 years. Early rig, Ford spark coil and Galena detector, 1921 rig Sears, Roebuck Meteor ½ kw trans. rotary gap, Murdock OT receiver home made tickler coil De-Forest double filament audion tub, 4 wire antenn. Member Alpha Sigma Delta, Iowa State Campus Radio Club, now Senior member of IEEE.



#648 DAY, Robert C., Ex-W1NRQ. Handle "Bob". Born April 18, 1898. First two way contact September 1910. Occup: Retired was General Traffic Manager, FARR ALPACA Co. General Supt. American Tissue Mills. Early rig, Manhattan elect. supply spark coil powered with bank of Salammoniac cells with carbon and zinc electrodes in series paralell, Galena detector and slide tuner. S.K.



#649 CLEMENT Lewis Mason, Ex-K4UR, K3AA, 6XC, WA3CKC. Handle "Lew". Born Jan. 25, 1892. First 2-way contact 1906. Occup: Radio Industry 1914 to 1963. Now retired. Early rig, 1905 receiver carbon blocks, 1902 2 in. spark coil electrolytic detector, then a 3 kw spark, antenna 90 ft. high. Member BCWTA 1907-14, IRE, IEEE 1914, Radio Club of America 1919, ARRL, 1964, Mt. Airy UHF Radio Club 65.
