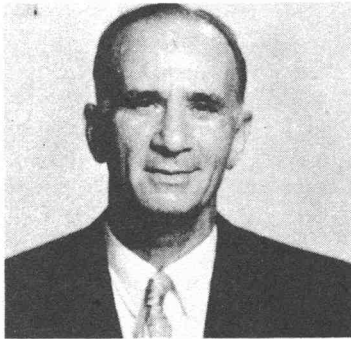




#665 ABLOWICH, Dave Jr., Ex-W60C, Ex-5DW, W5DW, W0DW. Handle "Dave". Born May 15, 1904. First two way contact 1919. Occup: Electronic Engineer, Head of Electronic Development and Evaluation Div. Bureau of Naval Weapons, Pomona. With WOAF, 1923, KFPM, 1924-34, WRR, KVP, KVPA, Dallas 1936-40. FCC, 1940-59, USN Civil Service, 1959 to date. Made first 5th Dist. Amateur QSO with Antipodes (Z4AA) 1924. Early rig, $\frac{1}{2}$ kw rotary outfit, homemade loose coupler, Galena. Active in SS and CD contests. S.K. 1972



#666 KORSON, Alfred F., W5HUT, Ex-2AEI. Handle "Fred". Born January 15, 1904. First two way contact, 1922. Occup: Manufacturers Representative. In earlier years associated with RCA Comms as point to point operator, and from 1934 to 1943 was operator and technician in RCA's Central Office in New Orleans. In war plant work WW2, following which became self-employed as Mfgs. Rep. Member of N.O. Amateur Radio Club. EARLY rig, spark, crystal, then to VT2 tube transmitter. 1966 operate all bands on AM & SSB, with 1 kw. S.K. 1976.



#667 MOORE, James W., W1CX, Ex1HB, W1AOC. Handle "Jim". Born July 13, 1907. First two way contact 1924. Occup: Druggist. Graduated from RCA school, ship operator 10 years. FCC operator during 4 years WW2. Early rig, Hartley 5 watter. Member VWOA, QCWA, AWA, ARRL, Ellsworth Wireless Club. SK

#668 MCCORMICK, Walter D., W5WT, Ex-5ACS, 5AHK. Handle "Mac". Born March 5, 1907. First two way contact, 1921. Occup: Railroad Telegrapher. Until 1941 was with major oil company. Became associated with railroad just prior to WW2, found myself frozen to the job for the duration, and have remained on the job ever since. Have life long interest in Ham Radio. Early rig $\frac{1}{4}$ kw spark coil and Galena. S.K.



#669 COMMAGERE, Edward L., Ex-K5VMP. Handle "Ed". Born February 9, 1892. First 2-way contact, November 1907. Occup: Retired after 50 years with Tropical Radio Tel. Co. Early rig, spark coil, Leyden jars, Helix, spark gap Coherer and later crystal detector. Warrant Officer USNR, during WW1. Member ARRL, CD Amateur Club, and VWOA. Hold extra Grade amateur license. S.K. 1970.
