



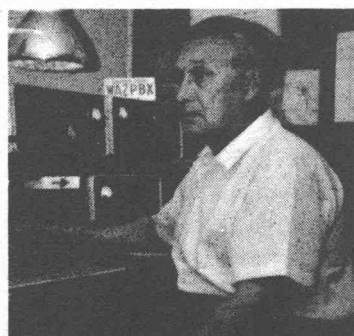

Committee that set limits and standards for limiting radiation from automobiles. Represented USA in CISPR as expert of automotive interference. Authored, "Automotive Radio Noise Elimination", QST April 1952. Early rig, 4-210A in LC Hartley circuit, loop mod homemade wet B batts. Member Purdue U Radio Club 1927-36. Radio Friends, The Ockenden Venture, WAC, DXCC, WAS, Old Timers Club, Rag Chewers Club, ARRL, 25 WPM, Proficiency certificate in 1965.



#675 ILLIAN, Donald E., W5SYX, Ex-I9CFW, W9EJD, W0EJD. Handle "Don". Born Sept. 18, 1908. First 2-way contact 1925. Occup: Poultryman. Was RM 1/C in USN. Had Electronic Shop in Oak Ridge, Tenn. and has been an Electrical Contractor and Construction Electrician. Member QCWA, OTC, MARS, CP/30, RCC. Early rig, 201 in Hartley on 160 meters, then 210 TPTG thence 203 TPTG.



#676 WELLS, John M., W1ZD, K4ZD, Ex-1TBJ. Handle "John". Born January 14, 1903. First two way contact 1919. Occup: Self employed. Investments etc., also chairman Massachusetts Aeronautics Commission. 1925 employed by American Optical Co., resigning from the company in 1940. Then became President and Treasurer of Harvey-Wells Electronics until 1957. Since that time have been associated with oil business. Director of Barco Corporation, Stanford, Conn. Early rig, 500 cycle 1/2 kw rotary quenched gap, then 4-UV202's with 400 volts, rec. home made loose coupler and Galena crystal detector. Member ARRL, Senior Member IRE.



#677 NEWMAN, R.G., N4RN, Ex-WA2PBX, Ex-W9CDI, WA2PBX. Handle "Ray". Born July 24, 1907. First two way contact 1925. Occup: President, Custom Cartage, Detroit Trucking and Lasham Cartage Co's.
