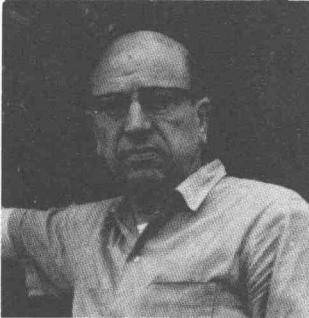

In 1937 became member of Fort Necessity Amateur Radio Club, now known as the Uniontown ARC, holding continuous membership, and presently Vice President. First rig, spark Xmtr 1919, in 1921 Pr. 202 in self rectified circuit. Active on bands since 1921, current rig (1966) home brew 1 kw AM phone.



#680 HEUBERGER, F. Robert, W4NNY exW2NWE, W9BOY, W2CEI Handle "Bob". Born December 19, 1908. First two way contact 1923. Occup: Operations Engineer, CBS Television, Columbia Broadcasting System. Has performed in all divisions. Member ARRL, QCWA, OTC, SS Banders, YL International, Society of Motion Picture and Television Engineers. Has son and daughter and six grandchildren. First rig, 1 kw rotary spark then to CW.



#681 BLAKE, Walton E., W1AMP, Ex-1AII. Handle "Walt". First two way contact 1922. Retired from civil service after 45 years. Supervisory Equipment Specialist for U.S. Government at Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth, N.H., prior to retirement in 1965. Early rig 1 in. spark coil W/Helix (200) meters homemade rotary gap in 1924 the new rig was 2-VT2's modulated by a pair of VT2's (Heising Modulation). Charter member of the following clubs which are no longer active, Radio Amateurs of Southern Maine and N.H., Great Bay Radio Club.
