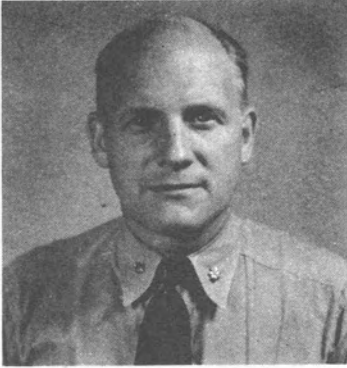

Cincinnati, Professional Photographer, Partner in Television and Radio Business (1930-1938) Woodward High School, Univ. of Cincinnati Electrical Engineering, Xavier U. Business Administration. Early rig, experimental 1 in. spark coil. Licensed rig was a 2 tube 5 watters (202'S) CW. Then added modulators Heising Mod. 2 additional tubes. Member and Chairman Dayton Chapter QCWA, Past pres. Greater Cincinnati Amateur Radio Assn., Queen City Emer. Net. Oh-Ky-In VHF Society, ARRL, also a Commander U.S. Naval Reserve.



#705 ARCHIBALD, John O., Ex-K2JG, 2Me, 2MB. Handle "Jack". Born June 5, 1895. First two way contact, 1909. Occup: Retired Gould Battery Co., DEPEW, N.Y. Inspection, Prod. Mgr., Supt. 2nd Lt. Signal Corps, WWI. Manufacturers Agent, Refractory Products, Office Buffalo, N.Y. Early rig, auto spark coil, 4 wire ant. 3 slide tuner, Galena Silicon, single telephone rec. S.K.



#706 SWANK, Jerrold A., W8HXR, Ex-W9KRI, 8ADD. Born February 21, 1904. Handle "Jerry". First two way contact June 1920. Occup: President Swank Films, Inc., Dayton Ohio Producer of Training Films. First rig 550 watt with rotary gap A ion detector, wrote articles for Radio news. Off air for college, back as W9KRI. When engineer for KYW in Chicago, 1932-1934 Asst. Chief Engineer WHIO 1935-43. Chief Editorial Branch Motion Picture Department Wright Field 1943-46. Swank Films Inc. since 1946. Main activity phone patches with Navy ships and Antarctica on 40 meters.



#707 MEYERSON, Leo I., W0GFQ, Ex-W9GFQ. Handle "Leo". Born March 7, 1911. First two way contact, 1925. Occup: Electronic Dist. and Mfgr. started WRL. Radio Business March 1935. Made Quartz crystals during WW2. Organized Globe Electronics in 1916, sold out to Textron 1960, organized Galaxy Electronics in 1963. Early rig, Mopa using 212D and 210's also modulated oscillator, with loop modulator in ant. circuit. Member Council Bluffs Radio Operators Club and AK-SAR-BEN Radio of Omaha, Neb. TROWL Club of Calif. Past President Kiwanis, Member Elks, Shriner, BNA Brith & Scottish Rite.
