Early rig, two slide tuner silicon detector, trans. splitdorf spark coil, with Helix, after WW1 added Leyden jars and sal-ammoniac battery for power. Past Commander United States Power Squadron. Past member of Fellsway Radio Club 1930-1931, registered Professional Engineer Senior Member IRE, President Eastern States Radio League.



#709 JONES, Loren F., WA3JUN, Ex-9ACB. Handle "Loren". Born July 4, 1905. First 2-way contact 1916. Occup: Manager of new business, Engineering, RCA Princeton, N.J. Designing Super-power Transmitters. First rig Ford spark coil up to 1kw Tyne - rotary to CW and phone member St. Louis R.C., Sigma Xi, Sr. member IEEE.



#710 LANG, Stanley W., W1IW, Ex-1GK, 1AZD, 1FLD. Handle "Stan". Born July 29, 1900. First 2-way contact 1912. Occup: Retired, helped engineer at 1XG, General Electric Co., experimental station until joining regular U.S. Navy July 1917 until March 1919. Early rig, Ford spark coil, then a 2 kw. First love CW. Work SSB and AM, Amateur Extra First.



#711 TYNE, Gerald F.J., Ex-8KN. Handle "Jerry". Born Dec. 22, 1899. First 2-way contact 1911. Occup: Retired from the Bell Telephone Lab. Collector of vacuum tubes, and information pertaining to such since 1920's. Author of "The Saga of the Vacuum Tube" in Radio News, 1943-46. Early rig, single slide tuner, carbon mike det. and 80 ohm recvr. 1" spark coil, tin foil coated drinking glass cond. Straight spark gap. Antenna 10 wire, 1 1/2 ft. apart 60 ft. long. At one time was member ARRL and Radio Club of America.
