

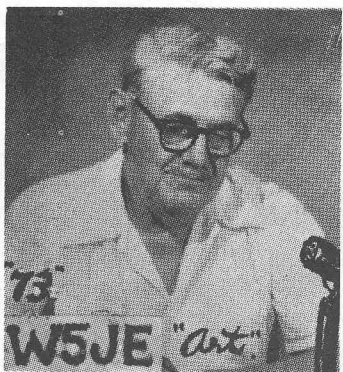
#716 BOYNTON, Walter H., WLYI. Handle "Walt". Born May 10, 1904. First 2-way contact, 1920. Occup: Senior Technician, Electronics Systems Lab. Inst. Room, Mass. Started as Electric Motor Construction, winding and repair, then into Radio Service work, in 1940 decided to try servicing automatic drinking cup machines and did so until 1942. Went to work as Electronic Technician at Harvard Univ. Radio Res. Lab. until 1945. Started at M.I.T.'s Servo Lab, now known as Elec. Systems Lab. Early rig, home-made one slide tuning coil and Galena detector with Murdock 55 phones, trans. 2 Ford coils. Member 1921 Dedham Community Radio Club, 1922 Parkway Radio Club, 1933 to date Norfolk County Radio Assn., also was member of Old Eastern Mass. Radio Club.



#717 CHAPMAN, Robert York, W1QV, Ex-1QV. Handle "Bob". Born Aug. 9, 1907. First 2-way contact Aug. 12, 1924. Occup: Research Electronic Engineer and Director, Acoustical Research and Development Div., U.S. Naval Submarine Base, New London, Conn. Early rig, Hartley circuit UV203, four wire flat top and counterpoise. Member of Westerly R.I. Club in 1923. Stonington High School Club 1945, Bremerton, Wash. Radio Club 1941, Quannapowitt Radio Club 1965 to date. ARRL DX section winner twice, Member BPOE #2163, Sphinx Temple, Hartford, Conn., New England Div. ARRL Director.



#718 KING, Ford, Ex-ASSO. Born Oct. 3, 1890. Occup: Retired 1955 from Tidewater Oil Co. Made one trip on steam schooner Carlos (San Francisco to Willapa Harbor, Washington State) 1910, no license required at that time. Short transmission period around San Francisco Bay area with spark coil 1908. Member Bay Counties Wireless Telegraph Assoc. 1909-1912.



#719 MATTES, Arthur S., Ex- W5JE, 3PA, W3JD. Handle "Art". Born July 11, 1901. First 2-way contact Jan. 24, 1925. Occup: Radio Officer. Have held Comm. license since 1926 continuous. Early rig, UV202, later added another 5 watter in self-rectified CKT. ANT. 60 ft. long cage and same lead in 1DH trans. CKT. Recently joined Veteran Wireless Operators' Assoc. S.K.
