

#763 McGARGAR, Jonas Lincoln, W6EY, Ex-6LK. Handle "Mac". Born February 29, 1896. First two way contact 1911. Occup: Retired. Was Assistant General Agent of So. Pac. RR Co. Was Ship Operator and RR Telegrapher 1913-1925. CRM USN WW1 and after. Was Chief on USS George Washington, taking Pres. Wilson to Peace Conference after WW1 - on his final trip. Director and Vice President of ARRL 1936-1950. ARRL member since 1915.



#764 SPICER, Roger M., Ex-K4FC, 1BVG, 1BG, W1BV. Handle "Roger". Born September 11, 1904. First two way contact 1916. Occup: Retired. Rah Broadcast Stns. in early years. Member of Lake Amateur Assoc. in Leesburg. Former member Wireless Associations located in Springfield, Mass., Holyoke and Pittsfield, Mass. Used to handle traffic from Germany and Chicago, 1923. Early rig, 1" spark coil, built the Reinartz Tuner 1920. Later a DeForest "h" tube in a Hartley. Of the early days: "In April 1917 Cops came and my OM got scared - used pliers on my aerial".

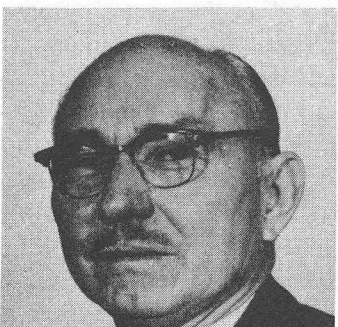


#765 FISCHER, Herman A. WA2QGV, Ex-2AT, 2BFX. Handle "Bud". Born February 24, 1899. First two way contact 1913. Occup: Retired Accountant, was with Mack Trucks 25 years. Commercial operator KTB Gulfstream, and KUA both of Gulf Ref. Co. and several other lines. Early rig, UV210 and homebrew. Receiver regn. R.C. Recently Morris R.C. of Morristown, N.J. Member of AWA, Holcomb, N.Y.



#766 NICHOLS, Charles E., W9AJ, Ex-8AA, W9FXI. Handle "Nick". Born June 7, 1892. First two way contact October, 1922. Occup: Retired Train Dispatcher. Early rig, transmitter 5 watt tube AC on plate about 10 watts. Receiver 1 tube detector and twin variometers and coupler. Member of ARRL and QCWA.

#767 VOGEL, Joseph L., W1AEH, Ex-1AAK. Handle "Joe". Born January 22, 1903. First two way contact 1918. Occup: Retired. Early rig, 1 inch Mescospark coil, Marconi Gap, loose coupler, Bunnell detector. Member Al Operators Club, Professional Loafers Club. SK



#768 MATHEWS, Eugene, W7QL, Ex-W9QBG, W5GRV. Handle "Gene". Born July 25, 1905. First two way contact 1923. Occup: Retired in 1962 after 32 years with Federal Aviation Agency. Operated in Navy, 1923, aboard USS California. Loaned by the Navy for Comm. Ship Operating, in the '20's at Canal Zone. Member QCWA, CHC, TOPS, FOC. Hold about 300 certs. and operates S line all bands, all modes. Have CP/35, and A-1 Operator. Early rig, P.O. 45's. When retired was Chief, Maintenance Operations, Western Region. FAA.
