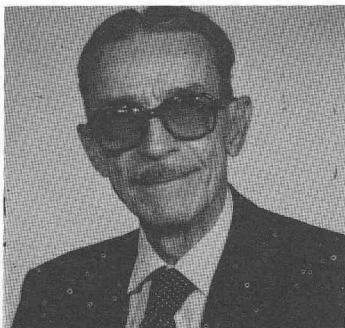

#791 CROWELL, Frederick C., JR., W9MIB, Ex9DIP, W9LXF, W4LXF. Handle "Fred". Born August 7, 1906. First two way contact March 1919. Present occupation President and Editor. The Insurance Field Co., Louisville, Ky. Early rig, 1 KW rotary gap spark, crystal receiver, EE Iowa State U, ending in journalism. Been in publishing business ever since. In Louisville area since 1938. Member Des Moines Radio Club, Heart of America Radio Club, Arts in Louisville, New Albany Radio Club, ARRL, AREA, CHC #38.
