

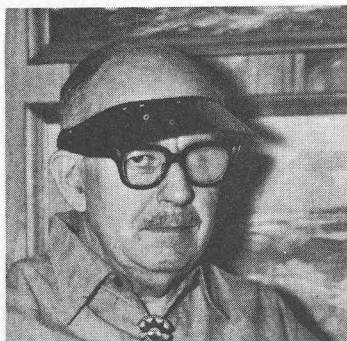


#799 STROM, Edwin W., W1ACJ. Handle "Ed". Born June 26, 1904. First two way contact 1923. Occup: retired Data Processing Technician and Electrician. Member of ARRL. Early rig Ford spark coil with fixed tap, Helix receiver, loose coupler crystal detector. Developed a CW outfit later.

#800 BROWNING, Gus M., W4BPD, Ex-4ABD, W3BBH. Handle "Gus". Born November 25, 1908. First two way contact 1925. Occup: Publisher, DX-ers Magazine. Spent 6 years operating DXpeditions in 117 countries, using 121 different calls. Owned WPBD. Operated in every state in U.S. Hold Commercial ticket. Member QCWA, ARRL, et al. First rig, Push pull 201's running 6 watts, working 30 countries. "Travel a lot...like the 'Old Timers'... like to recall the good ole days....Ham Radio is my life time hobby."



#801 McGLASHAN, Alexander, K2GIN, Ex-1AGV, W1SAO. Handle "Mac". Born April 1, 1907. A native of Scotland. First two way contact 1926. Occup: Quality Assurance Inspector, Electronic Equipment. Holds comm. licenses. Was with WFCI in 1927. In U.S. Navy 1928-1952, retiring as Lieutenant. Member of ARRL, QCWA, et al. Married, three children, number of grandchildren, with the OM being the only HAM. First rig: UX210 Hartley.



#802 BYARS, Lloyd J., W7MY, Ex-W7SBD, W6SBD, 7MY. Handle "Lloyd". Born April 27, 1909. First two way contact 1925. Occup: Retired after 30 years with Federal Aviation Agency. Had five years in Merchant Marines as Radio Operator during spark era, also operated at Coast Stations KGN and KPH. Member ARRL and QCWA. A-1 Operator CP/35, and OPR. of the month. Early rig, Hartley, ckt with 5-watt bottles. Receiver a regen. det. and one stage audio.



#803 SWANSON, J. Allen, Jr., W5PM, Ex-5PM, W5DAQ. Handle "Jack". Born May 31, 1910. First two way contact 1926. Occup: Retired (to fishing, golfing, and hamming). Was Officer/ Charge Naval Radio Commandant 8th ND 1942. Then cruisers Pacific 1943-45. Staff Com. Div. Cru. 5. Is ARRL SCM for La. (1966). Member Corpus Christi and Houston Amateur Radio Clubs. QCWA, ARRL, First Class Ops. Club (England) TOPS, A-1 Opr. WAC, WAZ, DXCC. Early rig, 210 Hartley. DX have 322 cfmd. (1966).
