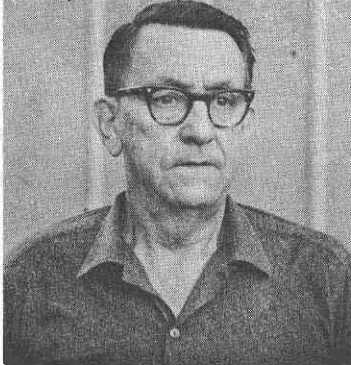


#809 WHALLEY, Cecil, VK6KK, Ex-G3EKK. Handle "Cec". Born May 21, 1900. First two way contact 1921. Occup: retired. Was Police Operator in Blackburn Lanes, England, 1935-49. From 1961-1966 was Radio Operator at Kuri Bay Outpost, on an isolated area 250 miles north of Broome, Aust. Member WIA, and formerly RSBG. Early rig, 7 valve R/C coupled RX. Xmtr. an 'R' Valve, with antenna from a mill chimney.



#810 RICKABY, Lorimer Douglas, VK4VR. Ex-VK2YY, VK2ACY, and PK6VR. Handle "Rick". Born April 26, 1906. First two way contact 1925. Occup: Bank Security Officer, Brisbane. Operated in Australian Navy 1924-1936, PO/Railways telegrapher 1937-1949. Rdo & TV Technician 1949-62. Early 1949 was instructor and operator for Dutch Govt. on Biak Island. Member Zero Beat R.C. Sydney. Full member WIA Prof. Rdo. Employees Inst. Retired full member IRE, Australia. Early rig, oil cooled UX201A TPTG 4 watts, end fed Zepp. Chem. rectifiers. 2-UX199a Schnell receiver.



#811 CENTO, Christy R., K5DWX, Ex-CR. Handle "Christy". Born August 1, 1900. First two way contact, 1913. Occup: retired. In USN 1918-21. Naval Radio School at Harvard. Attended Milwaukee School of Engineering, 1919-1920 and St. Mary's University, San Antonio. In Electrical Contracting Business 1923-46. Then retired. Built many miles of REA Power Lines and installed electrical systems in Federal and State Projects. Member AIEE, Electrical Contractors Ass'n., Delta traffic net, et al, early rig, Ford spark coil, quenched gap, Helix-Navy type loose coupler Galena.



#812 BULLOCK, J.C., W5GXO, Ex-W5DKG. Handle "Jake". Born August 22, 1907. First two way contact, 1920. Occup: Engaged in selling electronic equipment. Mfg. representative. Hold commercial ticket. Member IEEE, Greater New Orleans Radio Club, and Gideons International. Received Illinois Central R.R. award for valuable communications assistance during 1921 hurricane on Gulf Coast. Early rig, Ford spark coil, Oatmeal box Helix, Galena det. Swan 350 now on all bands.

#813 KAHN, Albert K4FW, Ex-9BBI, 9CCL, W9KYM. Handle "Al". Born July 9, 1906. First two way contact 1921. Occup: Corporation Officer, Founder of Electro-Voice Inc. Member ARRL, FOC, TOPS, DXCC, 280. Early rig ½ KW spark, rotary gap meteor. Homemade condenser and Helix, Boston key.
