

#829 RICE, Harold G., W4FOM, Ex-HR, 8CGE, W8HQY. Handle "Hal". Born February 22, 1904. First two-way contact 1922. Occup: Retired. Was associated with Ohio Bell Tel. Co. from 1924 to 1964 in Toledo, Zanesville, and Columbus, Ohio as Draftsman, Plant Engineer, and Salesman in commercial department. Former member of Teledo Radio Club. Early rig: Ford spark coil, thence to Rotary gap, a Radio Inspector checked and found my decrement too high on the rotary outfit in early 1920's, so I went to a 50 watt CW rig. Studied Electrical Engineering at Toledo University.



#830 WESTON, Irving L., K4NA, Ex-WlBHB, WlZX, W8IW, W9YJI and W9YHL. Handle "Irv". Born June 8, 1905. First two way contact 1923. Occup: Retired. Had 36 years with F.C.C. and predecessor agencies, and 3 years as Comms. Officer in U.S. Navy 1943-1946. WW2 Active Duty. Member IEEE, QCWA, and Radio Clubs in Providence, Boston and Annapolis, et al. Early rig, included Hartley Oscillator, single tube, CW and Loop mod. Hold commercial tickets. One of 1st early contacts was with W1KJ (OOTC) in 1923.



#831 GLODELL, Leroy Marcus, Ex-2AVY. Handle "Roy". Born May 24, 1902. First two way contact 1915. Sea duty aboard USS Eagle 34, Call NIBD, also held six other amateur calls. Lab. Asst. DeForest T & T Co. 1918-19. Svc. Mgr. Western Elect. Co. 1922-25. Wire Chief Cia. Tel & Tel. Mexicana, 1927-19--. Served to Col. AUS, 1941-60. Sigma Xi, DeForest Pioneers-Centro Radio Veteranos, Morse Telegraph Club, AMA, retired from Army-U.S. 1960.



#832 KILGARIFF, Joseph, Ex-VK5JT, Ex-VKZ. Handle "Joe". Born May 3, 1886. First two way contact, 1928. Occup: retired building contractor. Traveled world-wide in San Francisco 1906 earthquake. Was in railroad construction, Aust. As VKZ contacted McKays Exped. across South and West Aust. In 1939 Morse Code Instructor for RAAF. Member WlA, WBE, WAEDC, ARRL, WAS. Early rig, MOPA 210, roving through ether with my Moseley 3 band beam now fills my time.



#833 YEAGER, Carl J., W8DWT, Ex-8ADC. Handle "Carl". Born December 20, 1905. First two way contact, 1923. Occup: retired. Works part time, Inspector, Bowser-Morner Test Labs. Associated with the federal government for 37 years, wind tunnel, McCook Field, Tool and Gage Insp. Lab., and instrument inspection, Wright-Patterson AFB. Inspection 15, for Air Force. Univ. of Cinn. 1927-29. Member QCWA, Dayton ARC, MARS, et al. Early rig, spark coil, crystal, Holtzer fones, etc.
