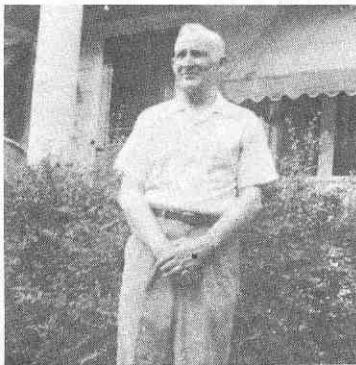




#840 JACOBSON, Max M., W3DUG, Ex-2AYK. Handle "Jake". Born July 12, 1899. First two way contact 1915. Occup: retired. Commercial Opr. 1919-1924 on North Atlantic runs. With WOKO 1925-26, WJZ 1926 until NBC was formed, then with NBC until 1960, retiring as Network Engineering Supervisor. Member QCWA, ARRL, and Rock Creek Amateur Radio Club. Early rig, 1 inch spark coil, home brew loose coupler. First trip at sea was on the last Whaleback on the Atlantic; KTQ, which blew a cylinder head off Florida and was towed back to N.Y. Active with SSB, scheduling NBC Retirees on Memo net.



#841 DEMEY, Georges, ON4OJ, Ex-E-G7, EB4DC. Handle "CW". Born Dec. 31, 1897. First two way contact, 1919. Occup: Retired Telegraph Officer, Wireless operator at Coast Station OST. In 1920 operator on board Belgian Government Mail Boats Ostend-Dover. In later years was in Telegraph offices at Brugge and Ostend. Member Reseau Belge (Now U.B.A.). Early rig, first tx made on a Sunday afternoon--on board mounted an LF Valve A409 Phillips, homemade coil, Var. Cond. H.T. came from 110v mains. Later added battery for 120v in series with 110, had 230v.



#842 OTT, James S., WA9IFO, Ex-9BUA. Handle "Stan". Born July 25, 1893. First two way contact 1925. Occup: retired railroader (1958) after 47 years service. In early days on Railroad was Morse Operator and Station Agent. Early rig, 5 watter. Now enjoy working CW on 80 and 40 mtrs.



#843 ANDRUS, Burton E., W5IN. Handle "Burt". Born Jan. 21, 1908. First two way contact 1923. Occup: Electronic Service. Hold commercial ticket. Member ARRL, Delta R.C. Early rig, 201-A.



#844 HERTZBERG, Joseph M., K3JH, Ex-8CYI, W8JE. Handle "Joe". Born September 3, 1907. First two way contact: 1923 Occup: retired, R.C.A., Lt. Col. USAF, WW2, Communications and Navigation problems. Member Rochester and Frankfort Amateur Radio Clubs. Early rig, UV202 with loop modulation oh 160 meters. Later 203A with bases removed for H.F. Now active (1967) on all bands from 3.5 mc to 144 mc. Amateur of year Dayton Hamvention 1976.
