Member 210 Club, ARRL, QCWA, VWOA, et al. to many to list here. Early rig, MOPA-210. CW only until added SSB in 1955. Holds ARRL Cert. No. 1 for first to QSO all states with SSB.



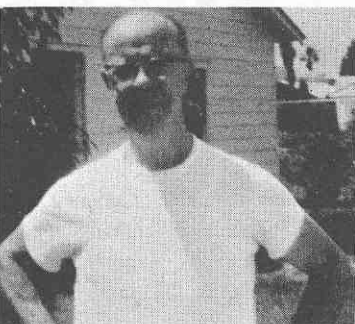
#846 MORGAN, Robert L., W5FM, Ex-W5FI. Handle "Leland". Born Jan. 9, 1909. First two way contact 1925. Worked as Geophysical Operator for McCollum Exploration Co. thru the South and in South America 1929-1933. Obtained commercial first class Radiotelephone ticket in 1932. Joined Humble Oil in 1936, member of management since 1945. Started with copper tubing coils, glass rods and crystal detectors. Became all-Ham family in 1951, when son Bob, W5VMW, got ticket. My XYL is Topsy W5PDU, daughter is W5VMV.



#847 EATON, Louis F., Ex-K1BS, K1LE, LEIN, IBS. Handle "Lou". Born September 6, 1893. First two way contact 1916. Occup: Retired. Had 40 years with Public Utilities. Graduated Amherst 1915, M.I.T. (E.E.) 1927. Operator at NAD in WW1. He inaugurated, with another, Harvard Naval Radio. Commissioned in 1918. Taught Electrical Engineering at Naval Academy. Had time at sea on USS Arizona and USS Pennsylvania. Member QCWA, former member IRE. Early rig, Clapp-Eastham ½ KW hystone quenched gap. First Fone operation in 1920. Call K1LE is for summer home Qth.



#848 HUTCHINSON, Harold A., W1BHA, Ex-1BNI, 1BHA, 1QEK. Handle "Hutch". Born June 27, 1903. First two way contact 1921. Occup: Engineer, Equipment Dept., N.E. Telephone Co. Has worked as Installer, Local Test, Toll Test, Plant Extension Engineering, and Equipment Engineering. Holds commercial ticket. Member Bangor and Augusta (Maine) ARC. Early rig, loose coupler and Xtal Detector, Spark Coil, Fixed Gap and Homemade Helix and condensers, all battery operated.



#849 MCSHEEHY, Morgan T., Ex-W4PFC/W4SEA, 8DUY, W8OJJ. Handle "Mac". Born September 17, 1904. First two way contact, 1927. Occup: retired Merchant (retail). Sold own business and retired in 1965. Member of ARRL, QCWA, AREC, St. Petersburg Amateur Radio Club, et al. Early rig, 201, later a 45 - with loose coupler and Galena detector. Actively interested in Amateur Radio since (1921) when I helped 3AAL build a 1 kw station with rotary gap.
