

#860 STINE, Earl, W4ZFJ, Ex-8BAA, W8JQN, WØEIL, W6UFL. Handle "Earl". Born July 13, 1906. First two way contact 1923. Occup: Plant Manager, Kellogg Company. Member Delta Radio Club.



#861 FRAZIER, George F., W1AOR, Ex-1AOR, W4TAI. Handle "Cap". Born April 22, 1906. First two way contact 1919. Occup: Retired. Industrial Engineer for most of his life. Commissioned Captain WW2, and retired with total physical disability from wartime injury. Back to school in 1955, graduating as Electronics Engineer, and now doing Engineering consultation and some design electronics. Early rig, Model T spark coil and crystal detector, thence to UV-202, "high power" and a regenerative detector using double filament audiotron. Member ARRL.

#862 LINDER, Earl R., W9DZG, Ex-9DZG. Handle "Earl". Born August 27, 1904. First two way contact 1921. Occup: Supervisor Labor Relations, Pennsylvania R.R., Chicago, Ill. Member Egyptian RC. in Granite City and Illinois Ham Club, Chicago. Early rig, two slide tuner Galena, Murdock Fones, thence to ¼ KW rotary spark Xmtr. Have been active on air for each of the past 46 years, practically all CW from the Spark Forever Days to the present.



#863 WEINIG, Robert F., Ex-WØDP, 8FK, 8DP, 8CIG. Handle "Bob". Born April 19, 1903. First two way contact 1916. Occup: Vice President and General Manager of Wincharger Corp. subsidiary of Zenith Radio Corp. Entire life spent in manufacturing and merchandising in electronic fields. Member QCWA, DXCC. Early rig, crystal and spark coil thence to rotary gap spark outfit, then to tube transmitters.



#864 GRANT, Irving F., W1LGRA, Ex-1CLW, K2VFO. Handle "Irv". Born January 15, 1902. First two way contact 1922. Occup: retired. Irv started experimenting with the building of Amateur gear right after WW1. He had Galena and spark coil in original rig, proceeding to 500 watt rotary spark outfit, and to audion valve with 2-stage amp. Still has the original Navy type key, and still has in a frame his original Amateur license.
