Occup: retired work part time, 5 years ship operator, radio broadcast in Seattle, Wash. 36 years at same station. Early rig, rotary spark, then 4 VT2's in parallel in Hartley circuit, with cage antenna and counterpoise. Member QCWA, ARRL, Walla Walla Radio Club. Radio Telephone and Telegraph 1st Class.

#890 COCKE, James W., Ex-JC. Handle "Jim". Born August 6, 1896. First two way contact 1923. Occup: retired from RCA. District and regional manager of every state in U.S. except New England. Early rig, spark coil, Marconi head set two wire antenna and crystal detector. Sales and Demonstration awards.

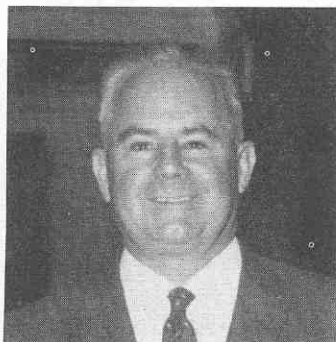
#891 BENSON, G.G., W5TM, Ex-9APC, W5GIH. Handle "Benson". Born August 27, 1904. Occup: Farmer. Telephone and telegraph first. Radio operator Merchant Marine 1924-1936. First trip out of Mobile, October 1924, SS West Jeffery to Northern Europe. 15 years Eastern Airlines. 15 years farming concurrent with BC work. Early rig, 3" spark coil, then a tube, shelf full of jelly glasses for rectifier.



#892 CLINKSCALES, R.L. W5IE, handle "Doc". Born December 1, 1897. First two way contact 1920. Occup: Optometrist. Early rig, 1 KW Thordarson, transformer, synchronous rotary gap, homebrew oil filled condenser, (glass battery jars), helix, receiver, Paragon tuner, homebrew detector, UV200 and UV202 audio amp. Member ARRL, Dallas Radio Club.



#893 SHULER, William R., W4KN, Ex-6CSJ, 6BC, W7GEW, W3IWM, et al. Handle "Bill". Born Jan. 16, 1911. First two way contact 1926. Occup: Director of Installations U.S. Army. Retired Major General, 31 years military service. 1927 managed WAC to start my DX hunt. West Point, Captain 1935 Army football team. All American left end. Biggest thrill first station on Guadalcanal, KH6VY/VR4, in 1949, using a rhombic and 1 KW, earned DXCC with four different calls. Three WAZ awards with three different calls. Early rig, 110 V.A.C. on a 201A Hartley lead-zinc strip in a borax solution on a 807. Homebrew receiver and trans. Member ARRL, DXCC, WAZ.



#894 NORTH, John, W2HP. Handle "Jack". Born May 5, 1900. First two way contact 1915. Occup: retired from Altec Lansing after 28 years. Have 50 year certificate from QCWA. EARly rig, bulldog spark coil from E.I. Co. then 3/4 KW Thordarson with rotary gap. Member ARRL, former president of Nassau Radio Club, Radio League of America, National Amateur Wireless Assoc.
