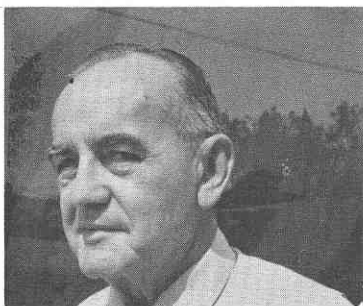




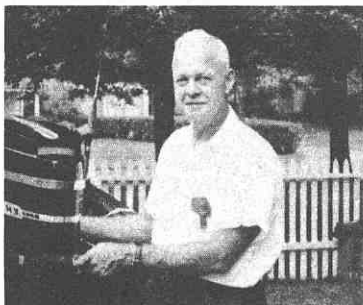

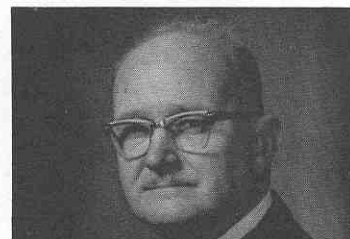

#958 LOVEJOY, Julian, W1BT. First on air 1911. Former calls W1BMV, W1EB. Belonged to Hartford Radio Club. Helped form ARRL.



#959 BATES, Art, W1RY. First on air 1922. Former calls 8RY, 9FQ, 9ME, W1ONV. Retired U.S. Navy Reserves and editor Amateur Radio Callbook 1927-1936.
