



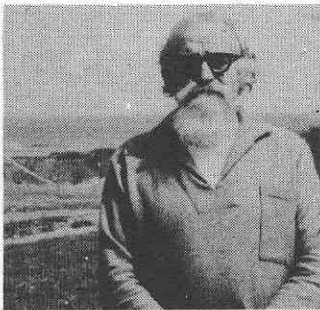
#1102 WALLACE, Fred J. WA4PLU, ex1WAN 1920. Radioman
