



#1246 NORTON, Clyde F. WØELA, Born 1913, first on air 1925 Member ARRL, WAC. DXCC, (top honor roll 1973-77) Twin City DX Ass'n, RCC A-1 Operator, FOC, Tau Beta Pi and Eta Kappa Nu (honoring Engineering and Electrical Engineering fraternities, respectively) QCWA, Handled traffic with the Byrd Antarctic Expedition, WFBT in 1929. In 1952 put VS5ELA on the air, the first amateur radio station ever on the air in Brunei.

#1247 KING, Arnold Jr. W2ZT, first on air 1931. exW9GIY, W2JJC

#1248 KING, Don E. K1ITU, Born 1909, first on air 1929. Was in WWII with 42 months in the Air force. Retired Master Sgt.



#1249 LINDQUIST, Rudolph H. W6SM ex6CLL W6ELF. First on air 1927 Born 1906 in Iowa.. In late 20's worked with Western Union, in 30's worked with electrical Power Company. WW2 was instructor at Navy Operations Training School. Retired Electrician teaching industrial Electronics part time at Modesto J. C. Mostly CW 40 & 80 Hobbies, wireless gear, photography, trailer-travel fishing.

#1250 KONITZ, Harvey F. W9G0 first contact 1910 date of first license 1913.

#1251 SLOAT, Orison B. W2FXP, ex WA2NMZ exW2BGC. First contact 1926 He was with the AEF in France as a radioman and worked other stations in 1918.

#1252 HOLCOMB, B.T. BGen USMC Ret GM5BD0/WA3MEK, Born 1908 first contact 1923. Started with Ford coil and home brewed equipment in 1924. Graduated Naval Academy in 1931. Also received call sign F6CPH
