

First licensed as 9ACG in 1922. Got his commercial ticket and sailed as opr on various liners. He is proficient in both American and continental morse. Sailed around the world on the Montgomery City KDJZ. Afterwards was a supervior in BC Stations WIBO, WFBM, WJJD, KYW etc., as design engineer. He is presently Director of Transmitter Engineering of Westinghouse Broadcasting Company.
