Built and owned Broadcasting station WIAX for three months provisional license, beginning Oct 1922 for 360 meters. Went to sea on the SS Carolina WFE 1925. Original opr along with Al Kroner, now K9AA at WTMJ Milwaukee Journal Transmitter 1927. Jan 1931 went back to sea on Shipping Board vessels. 4 years as broadcast tech at KGKY Scottsbluff Nebraska, along with extra duty of copying press Wireless he resigned to join the Civilian Signal Corps 1942. Went to Hawaii and assigned to WTJ transmitters. After 18 months returned to USA. Has 1st class Telegraph & Telephone.



#1739 FINCH, William G.H. Capt USN Associate. Born 6-28-97. First on air 1912 ex8LE, 8MK. Served in the Navy 1929-1959 Retired as Captain. Has Navy Legion of Merit, Wispom Award of Honor, Patent attorney, Licensed professional engineer, Fellow of IEEE. Fellow Radio Club of America. Has 180 patents in communications. He was awarded the Armstrong Medal for his important contributions to radio art and science. In 1921 he demonstrated a radio teleprinter based on early French invention, a highly sensitive relay and circuits. 1932 he established the first radio teleprinter press circuit in the US, between New York and Chicago. In 1933 the first international radio teleprinter circuit, for International News Service between New York and Havana. He was Vice Pres., and Chief Engineer for Hearst.
