for Leeds and Northrup Co., in North Wales, PA.

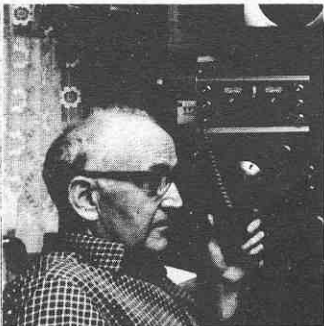


#1849 ROMANOW, William, W2DWJ. Born 7-5-11. First on air 1930.

#1850 DAVIS, Norman S Rev., W1IDR Born 10-22-02. First on air 1933.  
Graduate Bangor Theological Seminary 1929. Served parishes in  
Maine, New Hampshire and North Dakota where he met Mrs Davis.  
Retired from ministry 1952 and has worked some in business and any  
calls for professional service to this date (1975) Has a new SWAN

license. Was first 3BTP on the air with a Ford Spark Coil and

moved to California to work at old RKO Studio cutting room.  
Spent 41 yrs in studios and retired in 1972. Became W6LRC  
in 1935 and applied for 2 letter call after WWII, receiving W6MJ.
