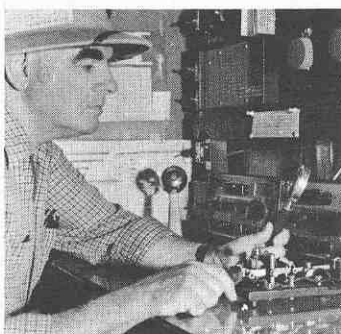




#1982 LAU, Henry S. Col USAF Ret KH6AW, ex W6FUC, K6GAS, K6GMQ, XU8GAS etc. Born 3-24-09. First on air 1927. Served in the USAF 1934-69. After a couple of years Ford spark coil went to a UV201 class with loop modulation. During WWII he was with the 7th Air Force, Air Defense Command in Hawaii. They operated the early warning system. He was on liaison duty with Hq CINCPAC at Makalapa 1943-45.



#1983 MORAN, J. Patrick, COL USAF Ret. W2EM Born 12-10-11 First on air as 1AED. Was morse operator prior to becoming a ham. First on ham bands 1928. At the time he was working for the Western Union Telegraph Co., and was a landline Morse opr. Later was employed by the New England Tel and Tel Co., working on many telephone and telegraph systems, and on experimental stations W1XAE-W1XAF on Cape Cod. He then went to work for Irving Vermilyea WIZE owner and operator of BC station WNBH, and police radio system WPFN. He went back to NE T&T worked in the toll telegraph department. Went in the military and was assigned to Hawaii 7th Fighter Coomand. Retired from the AF working in Radio Broadcasting in Washington DC, then joined the Bell Tel Labs in New Jersey He retired from Bell Labs in 1976.

#1984 SAWYER, Gordon E, W6HXX, ex W6BBZ, W6CMY. Born 8-27-05 First on air 1923. Was in commercial broadcast 1925-28 then sound engineer United Artists 1928-1974 Also for Goldwyn studios. Registered Engineer State of Calif. Member IEEE

#1985 HELLER, Gilbert L. W3CGZ, ex KA8GH DL4RL. Served in the USAF 1942-64. Retired Colonel. Pilot of SA-16 and RB-66 operated W3CGZ aeronautical. Active on most of the bands. Currently employed by a company devoted to computers and data procesising as a senior engineer.



#1986 KOPPMAN, Wallace L. WØYOB/WA7YKB ex W9YOB, Born 1908 First on air 1936. Built a one tube received in 1925.. Charter member Black Hills Amateur Radio Club, first transmitter 30 tube ten watts, receiver type 30 tube. Member WAS WAS RCC QCWA ISSB YL Worked on floods in Rapid City 1962 and 1972 Forest fires 1930's and 50's. Blizzard of 1949. Also member of Sun City Amateur Radio Club

#1987 KUNING, William A. W3BY ex W9ZBG, W4JCF . Born 5-2-20 First on air 1937. Served in the USAF 1941 to 1946 T/SGT

#1988 WOOD, George C. WA6HMT ex 6BWH. Born 5-9-04. First on air 1922. Started with loose couplers and Ford Spark coil. Attended Radio Institute in San Francisco Got his commercial ticket and went to sea 1923. To KPH in 1929
