ductions.



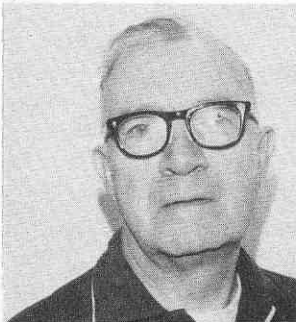
#2039 COOK, James W. W1EPZ, First on air 1910, Born 11-12-1895.
