#2091 MUNZIG, Arthur L. Jr. W6PYV, ex W6BY first on air 1930 Born 8-26-22. At age 15 received call W6PYV. Graduated from UCLA and the Naval ROTC program as an ensign, just in time to go thru Submarine school in New London. He sent the contact report from the sub USS Threadfish that resulted in the sinking of the Battleship Yamato. Started computer export business in 1959 and made more than 100 trips overseas. Was out of ham radio for a while, finally got the bug in 1977 and luckily got his old call back.



#2092 KLEPPIN, Elmer F. W9DB0. First on air 1931. Born 5-3-10 Before WWII worked mostly as a truck driver, during WWII worked as a radio optr and junior monitoring officer in the radio intelligence Division of FCC. After WWII worked in the Quality Control Dept of the Owens-Illinois Glass Co. Member of MARS.

#2094 WIİK, Edward M. LtCol USAR Ret. WØUGP exW9STL W7ILX First on air 1934 Born 10-22-14. Built first 3 tube TRF rcvr in 1931, mostly from salvaged parts from an old BC set. Got his license in 1934 and has been continuously on the air. Attended Univ. of Minnesota receiving Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering in 1939. Also took Rotc and commissioned a 2d Lt Ordnance in 1937. Active duty from 1940 thru 1945 serving in South and Southwest Pacific theater with 13th Air Force. Retired Lt. Col after 28 years service. Received Master of Public Health degree in 1971. Has directed the state Air Pollution Control program for past 10 yrs. Registered Professional Engineer. Member; ARRL, QCWA, Active 144-148.
