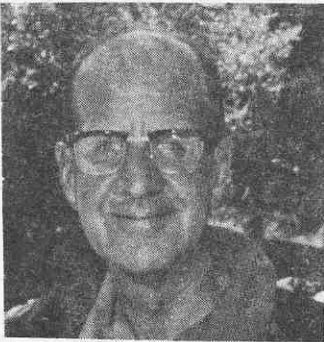


#2146 GREEN, Edward L W8QAY ex8ACA. Born 7-16-04 first on air 1919. Began with spark coil during WW1 Operated a  $\frac{1}{2}$ KW spark which had been his brothers. Used a super Benwood rotary spark gap with 16 points driven at 4000RPM. Was off the air for a while due to business and family, but got his general in 1977 and now is active.



#2147 KING, Albert J. W1QR, Born 11-13-03, first on air 1923, with Ford spark coil later  $\frac{1}{4}$ KW spark. Later got a Grebe CR\* rcvr and UV200 detector. Antenna 4 wire L. Still has original UV200 tube.



#2148 HABERLITZ, Eliot F. W6QZA Born 3-21-30 first on air 1938. Served in the US Navy 1928 1936. Electrical contractor in Santa Barbara from 1930 1963, then retired. Now in business with his hobby which was growing Cymbidium and Phalaenopsis Orchids. Has disposed of most of his collection of orchids but still do some hybridizing of Phalaenopsis orchids and maintains two houses of orchids at this time.
