#2219 ISSOKSON, Samuel B. K1CK, exW1MMI. First on air 1940.



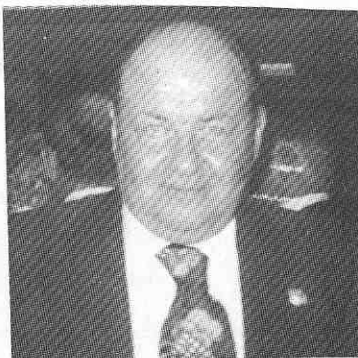
