First on air 1935. Served in the US Navy as
Chief Electronics Tech from 1942-45. At age of 15
he obtained his first call W7FHY. Conducted high
school sports program over KPQ Wenatchee radio
station. After the Navy stint returned to Wenatchee
got his first class radiotelephone License and
entered radio broadcasting as combination announ-
cer-operator at KVOS Bellingham, During WWII served
in the Pacific area. Had jobs at various broad-
casting stations and also worked for Martin-Marietta
and Boeing company in the scientific research lab.
Got a BSEE from the Univ of Washington. Worked for
Electronic Specialty Company and McDonnell Douglas.
He is a consultant in electronics an educator, a
psychologist, and an actor in films and TV



#2322 McCAULEY, R. C. W4AJZ,,exWA4WZF, Born 11-11-06
first on air 1929. Experimented with short range
spark in 1922, then 1922-29 in radio repair, and
worked part time in 2 broadcast stations. Active
on 75 and 2



#2323 TERRY, Fred P. KA6BUE, ex6XA Born 3-19-1896, first
on air 1910. Served in the US Army 1918-19.
Started in 1909 with crystal detector, spark coil,
then built a 1KW job rotary spark gap. After WWI
manufactured radio freq amplifiers in Oakland Cal.
1923 made the KFBK broadcasting station for Kimball-
Upson Co of Sacramento CA. It was later enlarged and
sold to the Sacramento Bee, still broadcasting today.

#2324 RUSSELL, David W. N8DR, exWB8QYZ, Born 5-16-03
first on air 1915.

#2325 AUSTIN, Charles W. III W1INN Born 5-15-12 first on
