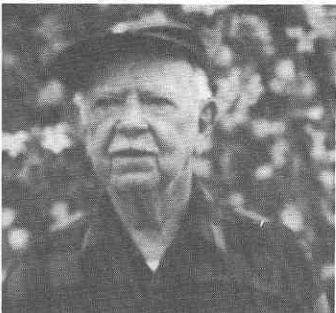




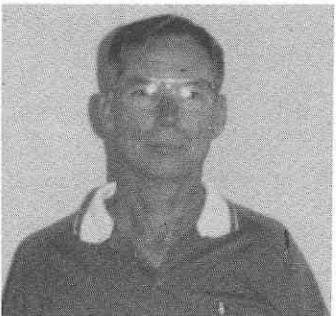
#2416 TWITCHELL, Herb D. W6BL exW6SKJ First on air 1935
