



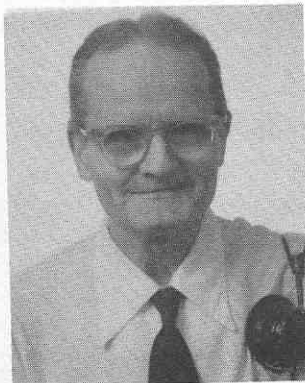
#2481 NANNIS, Eli K4JMH, exW1HKG. First on air 1931
